## INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUBMTTING THE APPLICATION

"To obtain the degree, the student submits, through the Director, a request for the assignment of the final paper to the student office. The request must be submitted to the competent Didactic Secretariat for the Degree Program [A. Salvatore <u>salvatorea@unime.it</u> – 0906765501], co-signed by the Supervisor, at least 90 days before the start of the first available graduation session. The date of the entry protocol shall be decisive for this purpose." (Art.13, paragraph 3 of the Didactic Regulations of the Bachelor's Degree Programs).

It is also noted that:" The final paper, with the approval of the Supervising Professor, must be submitted electronically by the candidate to the relevant administrative offices at least 7 days before the final exam. The paper is made available for viewing by the members of the graduation committee appointed by the Director for that graduation session." (Art. 13, paragraph 6 of the Didactic Regulations of the Bachelor's Degree Programs).
